

What to Expect

- At SCUBA VBS, kids will dive into friendship with God! SCUBA is filled with awesome Bible-learning experiences kids see, hear, and touch! Sciency-Fun Gizmos, team-building games, unforgettable Bible songs, and tasty treats are just a few of the standout activities that help faith flow into real life!
- Each participant will be assigned a VBS Crew and color. Kids will remain with these pre-assigned crews (we will accommodate friend requests as much as possible). You can help out by preparing your child to be excited for their crew.
- Since everything at VBS is hands-on, kids might get a little messy. Be sure to send them in play clothes and safe shoes.
- All games will be played outside.
- Children and staff will sanitize or wash hands between each station rotation.

Daily Information

Drop-off:

- Please drop off between 8:40am 8:55am each day. All vehicles should pull up to the tent in front of the gym entrance for check in (follow traffic directors in our parking lot).
- Kids will exit vehicles and get signed in for the day. A VBS volunteer will accompany them to their Crew Leaders inside the gym.
- Our program begins promptly at 9:00am. If you arrive late, enter through the front doors and a VBS volunteer will direct you.

Pick-up:

- Please park and pick up **inside the gym promptly at 12:00 PM**. Crew Leaders will sign the kids out and release them to you.
- Each day concludes with a *Fin-tastic Finale* that gets everyone involved in living what they've learned. Family and friends are invited to join us daily in the gym for this special time at 11:45am.

Other:

- The kids will participate in a service project during VBS week. Details to come!
- A snack will be provided each day. If your child has an allergy or dietary concern, please send an appropriate snack with them.
- Keep an eye out for your Parent Newsletter coming home each day after camp! It will share what the kids have learned and note any reminders for the following day.

Wellness Policy

At Bethel, we strive to provide a healthy environment for all and ask those experiencing symptoms of communicable illness to refrain from in-person activities.

In the last 5 days, if you (or someone you are bringing to VBS) has experienced *any* of the below symptoms of communicable illness, we ask that you please *keep them at home*.

- Fever (100.4°F or higher) or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Green nasal discharge
- Unexplainable rash
- Watery, matted eyes
- Head lice
