Why: Increase family readiness and resilience and build community through faith formation.

Concept of Operations:

A five day program that allows parents and children to learn in a multi-generational environment. Vacation Bible School program includes four core elements that produce the desired outcome of the curriculum.

- 1. Single-point learning:** Program Theme and one memorable quotable point reinforced throughout every section of the program each day.
- 2. Family reinforcement:** allows families to reinforce lessons learned and continue exploring learning content at home.
- 3. Engage all learning styles:** Brings curriculum to life by reinforcing the daily lesson with Visual, Auditory, Kinesthetic, and reading/writing learning style.
- 4. Build Community:** The strain of military lifestyle and a global pandemic have isolated families and caused untold damage to the community. Bringing families together and connecting them in vital relationships is a step toward community building.
