Dear Parent,

Welcome to *Shipwrecked VBS*—*Rescued by Jesus*! Shipwrecked VBS uses sight, sound, and touch to help children experience Bible stories in ways that help faith flow into real life. (And yes, we might all get a little messy, so be sure to send your children in play clothes and safe shoes.) Plus, we'll help kids discover how to see evidence of God in everyday life—something we call *God Sightings*. Get ready to hear *that* phrase a lot!

During Shipwrecked VBS your child will also have the opportunity to participate in two mission projects—one global and one local. First, we will collect money to help provide drought tolerant fruit and vegetable seeds for Haitian families through *Group VBS's Operation Kid-to-Kid/* Second, we will collect canned/boxed foods for a *local food pantry*. Additional information about these projects is attached to this letter.

Each evening will begin in the **Family Life Center** where you can **pick up your child's nametag** and your **Security Card** to be *used each night during pick-up*. Supper will be served by 5:30PM. At 6:00PM children will attend Castaway Sing & Play in the Sanctuary. Afterwards, Crews will travel in larger groups to the Shipwrecked stations: Bible Discovery, Ship Rec Games, and Imagination Station/Preschool Craft & Play.

<u>Dismissal for Preschool through rising 1st graders</u> will begin at **7:40PM** each night from the child's last rotation room (indicated on the **Security Card**). Members of the Security Team will direct you to the Children's Department (located in the hallway behind the Sanctuary). If you have older children (rising 2<sup>nd</sup>-rising 6<sup>th</sup> graders), you may choose to pick them up at the same time or to return for their dismissal at 8:20PM (the last elementary rotation ends at 7:55PM). If you plan to pick up your elementary-aged children early, please respond to this email (amy@hvbc.org) with your name and the preschool and elementary children's names.

Everyone is invited to join us in the sanctuary each day at 7:55PM for our daily finale, *Sail Away Sendoff*. However, for safety reasons we ask that you keep any younger children in the pew with you and that the elementary children remain with their Crew Leaders until dismissal.

<u>Dismissal for Elementary children (rising 2<sup>nd</sup>-rising 6<sup>th</sup> graders)</u> will begin by **8:20PM** each night. Children will not be allowed to leave the sanctuary until a <u>parent</u> or <u>designated adult</u> (with a **Security Card**) has signed them out. **There will be NO exceptions,** so please make sure someone is present to meet your child every night. Your child must remain with his/her Crew Leader until the leader has your signature. Once you've signed-out your child(ren), we ask that you quickly exit the sanctuary area so that our volunteers can begin their nightly staff meeting and devotional time.

## Operation Kid-to-Kid

# Yates Baptist Association Food Pantry

The Yates Baptist Association Food Pantry is a ministry that provides food and the Gospel message to those in need in the City of Durham. The YBA Food Pantry is located at Antioch Baptist Church (1415 Holloway Street, Durham, NC). Anyone in need of food assistance can call and make an appointment. Food is distributed each Tuesday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. In November, the YBA Food Pantry prepares special "Thanksgiving Baskets" which are given out free of charge to those in need. Each basket contains a 12-15-pound turkey, fresh collards, sweet potatoes, homemade pies, rolls and all the fixings for a Thanksgiving dinner. During all the appointments, individuals are given the opportunity to learn about Jesus and have someone pray with them. The YBA Food Pantry strives to not simply meet the physical needs of each person but to meet their spiritual need as well.
