WHAT IS VBS – Vacation Bible School?

Take kids back to Hometown Nazareth, where they'll stand up for their faith among people who doubt that a carpenter's son is really God's Son.

Every day at VBS, your child will have the chance to sing, dance, play, do crafts, and learn with their imagination. During the week of VBS, the children will see that JESUS is just like each of us.

HOW OLD DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO BE TO PARTICIPATE?

We welcome all children from kindergarten (entering Fall 2024) to fifth grade, ages 5 – 11/ Children must be potty trained. If you are in 6th – 12th grade, you may volunteer this week as leaders. Service hours are available!

WILL MY CHILD CONNECT WITH KIDS THEIR AGE?

Yes! Children will be placed into grade level groups, according to the grade level they will be entering in the Fall. They will share their experience with peers their age.

HOW LONG IS EACH DAY?

VBS takes place from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm each day, Monday through Friday, July 15 to July 19.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The total cost is \$80 per child, including a t-shirt, snacks, crafts & fun surprises!
