

In an effort to make sure that all our kids are safe and able to enjoy their time at **Overnight VBS 2022** we have a behavior agreement that we need all campers and parents/guardians to be aware of. While attending VBS Overnight, campers are expected to behave appropriately and follow all rules and regulations. We strive to provide a fun, safe, supportive, and exciting learning environment for everyone involved and where Christ's message can be revealed.

All campers attending Overnight VBS 2022 will:

- Follow instructions given by all VBS Overnight leaders
- Respect themselves and others
- Use appropriate language
- Respect the environment, equipment, property, and other campers' belongings (camper and parent/guardian will be liable to cover the cost of damages)
- Not cause physical or emotional harm to other campers or volunteers
- Remain in their cabin after lights out is called
- Participate and remain with their small group leader while on trails and during activities

Failure to abide by these rules will result in the following:

- 1. Overnight VBS volunteers or LCF paid staff will discuss the behavior with camper
- 2. Camper may be given a supervised "time out" and not allowed to participate in a subsequent activity
- 3. Camper may be asked to leave camp in which parent/guardian is responsible for providing transportation home as soon as possible including during night.
