



Welcome to Immanuel Ninja Warrior Camp! CHECK IN AND DROP OFF & DISMISSAL AND PICK UP INFORMATION

Ninja Warrior Week will bring almost 500 kids into our church building! To accommodate this large number of children every night, we have new guidelines in place so that we can receive and dismiss all participants in a safe and secure manner. Our goal is to ensure a quick, easy and safe check-in and check-out process.

In previous VBS years, we have held a closing each night (about 20 minutes) inviting parents to join. We would finish that day's lesson, wrap up with an overview, sing some songs, make announcements and then start dismissal.

For this event, we are modifying our programming to give all these kids quality time on the Ninja Training and Obstacle Courses. Therefore, we will not be holding a formal closing every night, inviting parents to observe. All kids groups will meet in the Worship Center for a very brief closing and then we will begin the dismissal process.

Our check-in and drop-off procedures have also been modified, again, so we can receive all children safely and securely. We ask in advance, that parents and guardians are patient as we check-in and check-out all of these children in a safe and secure manner. Specific check-in and drop-off/dismissal and pick-up procedures will be communicated by email to all families prior to the start of Ninja Warrior Week. Please be on the lookout for this information as we approach July 22.

Immanuel Ninja Warrior Camp will NOT be an event that parents can stay to watch. For the safety and security of all children attending, only participants and volunteers will be permitted on site for the duration of Ninja Warrior Camp. This event is comparable to Vacation Bible School and FCA Sports Camp, where parents check-in, drop off and leave, returning for dismissal and pick up.
