Student Volunteer Application 2018 Summer Camps

Hello Students!

Summer is only a few weeks away which means our summer camps are rapidly approaching. This summer there will again be three summer camps offered at New Hope. <u>We need your help in staffing the camps</u>. <u>Without you, we couldn't offer these camps to the children in our community.</u> Any student in middle school or high school may apply.

Here is our 2018 Summer Camp lineup:

Kids Camp (VBS)

Monday through Friday, June 11 - 15

For Preschoolers (ages 4 &5) & Elementary Age Children in Grades 1-6

Students are needed to work with a group of children as Team Leaders and travel with them through the various stations throughout the morning. Other students are needed to be "Station" assistants, help with snacks and games. Approximately 30 to 40 volunteers are needed. 8th-12th graders may apply.

Upward Basketball & Cheer Camp

Monday through Friday, June 18-22 For Elementary Age Children in Grades 1-6

Students are needed to work with a team of 6 to 10 children, leading them to five different teaching stations, and supervising their team during scrimmages. A few students will also be needed to help prepare and serve refreshments during the daily snack time. Approximately 20 to 25 students are needed.

Arts Camp

Monday through Friday, June 25-29

For Elementary Age Children in Grades 1-6

Students are needed to assist the various teachers at their stations. Other students are needed to supervise a group of children as they travel to the various stations throughout the morning & during snack time. Only 6 students will be compensated (see below). Approximately 12-15 students are needed.

Both the Upward Basketball/Cheer Camp and Kids Camp are volunteer positions. Those working in the Arts Camp are compensated. \$100 will be placed in the student's account at New Hope which can be used to pay for various events and activities associated with the New Hope Student Ministry. <u>To apply to work at the Arts Camp, the applicant must have volunteered at either the Upward Basketball/Cheer Camp or Kids Camp.</u> Students who volunteer at both camps will be given preferred status if applying to work at the Arts Camp. Each camp runs from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm Monday - Friday that week. Campers are at the church from 9 am till 12 noon.

To apply to volunteer/work at any camp, complete the form on the other side of this paper and turn it into the office or any New Hope Staff member. You are encouraged to do this as soon as possible, as only a limited number of workers are needed for each camp. Submitting an application does not guarantee your acceptance as a volunteer/worker.
