
Dear Parents or Guardians:



Drop-off and Pick-up

- Drop-off will be in the lobby of the church.
 An adult MUST accompany their child to the check-in table each night.

The Appleseed book will be used for Cubbies this year. Each week your Cubbie should come prepared to say the Bear Hug listed on that date and we will review it during AWANA. You can find the Bear Hugs listed on the schedule. Cubbies will participate in themes for fun and in the final closing program with all Awana. Since we will be using lanyards and pins for awards, vests are not required as uniforms but are available for purchase should you want to have one. Each week Cubbies pay dues or you can pay for the year which will help cover program costs and a snack each night.

Sparks is a self-paced memory program. In addition to their regular verse sections, at any time throughout the year, your child may do the Sparky Challenge. Your child must say each challenge to a leader, at least two times, and get the leader's approval before speaking before the group. Your child can only do 1 challenge per book. The challenges are as follows:

- 1st Book (Hang Glider) p. 69 Books of New Testament
- 2nd Book (Wing Runner) p. 48 Psalms 23
- 3rd Book (Sky Stormer) p. 17-18 All the books of the Bible (Old and New Testaments)

Sparks receive points each night for bringing their book, Bible, attending church, bringing a friend, the sections they say and participating in theme nights. At the end of the year they can spend their points in the Sparky store.

The BQ Club is a self-paced program. Every clubber will start with the Start Zone booklet this year which is the basic gospel message. Your child can say as many sections per night as they are prepared for as time allows. In order to pass a section, Clubbers must say the entire page with only 2 helps per page, not per verse.

There are 2 incentive programs, the camp contest and C.O.W. (Chewing on God's Word) verses. See additional pages for a more detailed explanation.
