Civilian criminal background checks are completed through the following agencies: MIPSOR (Michigan Police Sex Offender Registry), ICHAT (Internet Criminal History Access Tool) and OTIS (Offender Tracking Information System). These checks must be completed annually and will be kept confidential. There is no cost to the volunteer for these checks.

Convictions for the following crimes will prompt a determination that a volunteer does not meet the criteria to serve in youth or children's ministry.
