

Code of Dress and Conduct

Our purpose in conducting Vacation Bible School is that we might direct children into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Some of the children who attend our VBS might not otherwise have opportunity to learn of Jesus. Our appearance and demeanor is extremely important.

While serving on the staff of Bethany's VBS we ask that you follow these few simple rules of dress and conduct. We are not seeking to be legalistic in our approach but rather to present an appropriate Christian model for those who associate us with the ministry of Bethany Bible Church. For that reason, we will feel free to speak to you if either dress or conduct is deemed inappropriate.

DRESS:

Modest attire is expected; no spaghetti straps, halter tops, or skirts (long skirts are ok). Shorts should be "finger tip length" or longer.

Hats or T-shirts with offensive language will not be allowed. Appropriate corrective measures will be required for anyone wearing such clothing.

Gang related apparel or appearance will not be allowed.

CONDUCT:

Workers should take special care **to be attentive and engaged** for the entirety of the VBS day. Crew Guides and Assistants are encouraged to participate actively in each station with the children.

If you have any problems, talk to your leader first. If you cannot work it out with them, talk to the VBS Director or Kids Pastor. The VBS office will know where to find them. Please do not let problems go on. Deal with them as soon as you can!

Language that is derogatory or offensive will not be tolerated. Workers are expected to speak appropriately to the children and respectfully to their fellow workers at all times.

Those who smoke are asked not to smoke on the church campus.



TECHNOLOGY USE:

Cell phones and other electronics must be **silenced** and **hidden from view** unless they are being used in a ministry function or an emergency.

Any music played at VBS should be appropriate for a church setting. (Official VBS music is preferred.)
