



2024 - 2025 Safety Procedures

(Please Read Carefully):

Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us. Every volunteer and staff member complete a background check and training to ensure your child's safety.

When registering your child for Awana, online or in person, you will need to complete the authorized pickup names on the registration forms.

Each week when you arrive, your child will be checked in using our computerized check-in system, you will be given a randomly generated security code assigned only to your family. This code changes weekly. The code will print on a name tag for the child and one will be printed for you, the parent, guardian or authorized pickup person. This tag will also include any medical notes, such as allergies, that your child may have so all volunteers will be aware. This tag must be presented in order to pick up your child.

If someone other than the person who checked in your child, is picking them up, they will need to be provided with the number on the tag that was printed at check-in. Our suggestion is to take a picture of the tag and text it to them.

** Please note: we do not allow elementary aged children to check in or pick up their siblings.
