Daily Information

Drop-off:

- All vehicles should enter via the Doyle Rd entrance, please pull to the
 front door. Campers exit the car, have temperature taken, and given
 a name tag. Please do not leave until you have your security tag for
 pick-up.
- **Elementary kids** (Gr 1-5) will exit the vehicle and a VBS volunteer will accompany them to their group in the sanctuary.
- **Preschool Kids** will exit the vehicle and a VBS volunteer will escort them down our King's Kids hallway to their classroom.
- Check-In begins at 9:15 am, as VBS programming starts promptly at 9:30 am. If you arrive late, pull up to the front doors and a VBS Volunteer will direct you.
- All vehicles please exit using Braddock Rd.

Pick-Up:

- Please park your car and bring your Parent tag with three-digit code with you to pick up your child(ren).
- PreSchool Parents Pickup is at 12:15 from their room (see security tag
 for room #) Have your Parent Tag ready to show. You must have the
 matching code before your child is released. You may leave or take
 your child(ren) to the closing ceremony if you would like.
- Elementary Parents Head towards the Parent Pick Up Entrance –
 show your tag to enter the door. Locate your child, Show the crew
 leader your tag. Proceed towards the exit. You will need to show the
 volunteer at the door your tag, matching your child's tag, to exit.
- Once you exit the sanctuary doors you will not be permitted to enter again. Please make sure you have all your children and all your belongings before leaving.

VBS Snacks:

 Each day, campers will go to the Galactic Snack Station. Snacks will be carefully prepared by our staff, who will be wearing gloves and masks. Our staff are aware of all allergies and our snacks do not contain any allergens.
