Dear Confirmation Class of 2026 and Families,

We are excited to invite you to participate in **Confirmation 2026 at First Presbyterian Church of Morehead City**. This class is open to students in **6th grade and above** and is an important step in your faith journey.

Confirmation is a time to explore what it means to live as a Christian disciple and to learn more about being part of a Presbyterian church. During this process, you will have the opportunity to ask questions, grow in understanding, and reflect on your faith. Throughout the class, we will explore questions such as:

- What does it mean to be Presbyterian?
- What do Presbyterians believe?
- Why do we worship and serve the way we do?
- What does it mean to follow Jesus in everyday life?

Class Details:

- **Room 8, downstairs in the Education Hall** (*location change from original flyer*)
- **First class: Sunday, February 1**
- Classes will continue through **May 10**, with breaks for Easter and Spring Break.

The class will be led by **Mandy Vick and John Riley**, along with other members of the church who will serve as mentors for each confirmand. As part of the confirmation process, students will meet with the **Session (the Elders of the church)** and present a written **Statement of Faith**, which we will work on together during class. Confirmands will be publicly welcomed into church membership during worship on **Sunday, May 10**.

Because each step of the confirmation process builds on the next, **regular attendance is very important**. Completion of confirmation is based on participation in class discussions, weekly assignments, and regular meetings with your mentor. We understand that occasional conflicts may arise; however, any absences should be communicated to Mandy in advance, and make-up work may be required.

On May 10, the entire congregation will celebrate as you officially join the church family. We are so excited to walk alongside you during this meaningful and special time in your life and faith. We look forward to welcoming you as part of the **Confirmation Class of 2026**.
