- Be listening.
- Be kind with your words.

- Be safe.

Our expectations will be made clear during our opening the first night, as well as each following night and will be enforced throughout all areas of VBS.

We know that children need to be engaged in safe and age-appropriate activities, and that we cannot expect the same level of attention from a 3 year old that we do from a 12 year old. Therefore, our teachers and volunteers have been instructed and trained on how to properly enforce these expectations in an appropriate and fair manner.

In the case that a child is not following these expectations, we have implemented the following guidelines:

- 3 verbal warnings; if those interventions do not prove effective,
- Pastor Ted Rathman will speak with the child, and he will notify the parents of the situation.

We know the safety and care for your child is of utmost importance to you and we want you to know Grace Church is doing its part in creating a safe atmosphere where your child can also experience the fun and excitement that is VBS.
