



Welcome to our ROAR crew! We are thrilled that you will be with us this summer to plan and experience VBS with the children of Christ the King Church. It is going to be a fun and challenging adventure!

Leadership has responsibilities and expectations that come with it. Therefore, we want to be clear from the beginning about your role and the tasks to be completed by each teen leader.

- Teen leaders are expected to arrive by 8:45 a.m. daily to begin gathering their group of children in the assigned area or to prepare their station for the day. In addition, volunteers must stay until all children in their groups have been picked up, approximately 12:45 each day (1:15 on Friday).
- Teen leaders must stay with their assigned group or in their station at all times. A break will be given to station leaders, during which you are invited to enjoy the day's snack or drinks from the kitchen. Group leaders should enjoy snacks during their group's assigned snack time.
- Teens are asked to wear their nametags at all times. This helps the children and adults know you are supposed to be with us and with what group you belong. We appreciate your cooperation with this.
- Teens are expected to participate fully in all activities. If you don't participate, the younger children will not want to participate.
- All teens are expected to attend and assist with the family night program on Thursday (arrive by 6:30 p.m.). Please make arrangements now to be there.
- Any teen not meeting the expectations or causing distractions from the VBS experience will be asked to leave the program for the week. Parents will be contacted and are expected to pick up their teen immediately.
- Cussing and inappropriate language will not be tolerated and warrants immediate dismissal from the program. In addition, cell phones, electronics and books/novels are not to be used during VBS.
- Service hours may be awarded for this week of fun and the preparation work as well. Letters with the completed hours will be distributed to each teen at the end of ROAR based on your level of participation.

While we do not expect any problems to arise, we want to be as clear as we can about our expectations. We value the youth of our parish and are glad you have an interest in serving in this ministry. We want it to be a fun experience for you and hope you know we want your input and ideas along the way.
